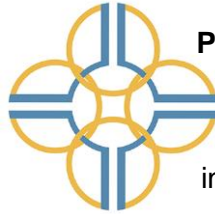

This deposit will not be transferred to Travelbound until we have reached the 30-student requirement for the trip. **Please note:** deposits, are **non-refundable**. If a student is unable to take part in a trip after further monies have been paid, the school will endeavour to recoup costs on the student's behalf by finding another student to take their place. However, please note that this is **not** always possible, owing to group booking terms and conditions and cancellation fees.

The initial deposit will be **£200** followed by **three** instalments of **£200** and **one** of **£199**, which will be collected at the start of each month from **September to December** (a payment schedule will be sent nearer the time).
