Subject Specific Strategies for Revising	<ul> <li>Apply specific factual information about the public services to scenario-based questions e.g. knowing that the police take witness statements and discussing how they would do so at the scene of a car accident</li> <li>Recall of key word specific definitions</li> <li>Explain the purpose of each public service and their associated responsibilities</li> <li>Link the associated responsible government departments to each public service</li> <li>Explain the advantages and disadvantages of public services working together</li> <li>Application of delivery models to different public service projects</li> <li>Explain how public services are funded and the impact of funding on service delivery</li> <li>Recognise the difference between give, describe, and explain questions and the level of detail required for each</li> <li>Mind maps for grouping information together</li> <li>Colour-coded key word definition cards (provided by teacher) can be used for a range of exercises e.g. match up, memory etc.</li> <li>Make flash cards to learn facts</li> </ul>
