Question 4 - write a structured piece of extended writing in French. There will be five bullet points and you should aim to write 80-100 words in total for this question - ie each paragraph should contain approximately 16 - 20 words. Three paragraphs will be in the present tense, one will be in a past time frame and one will be in a future or conditional time frame. You must answer all five of the bullet points

- The Higher Writing examination has four questions

Question 1 - write single sentences in Spanish and is the common question with the Foundation Tier paper

Question 2 - write single sentences in Spanish
Question 3 will be a translation exercise. You will translate 5 short sentences from English into Spanish
Question 4 - write a structured piece of extended writing in French. There will be five bullet points and you should aim to write 130-150 words in total for this question - ie each paragraph should contain approximately 26 - 30 words. Three paragraphs will be in the present tense, one will be in a past time frame and one will be in a future or conditional time frame. You must answer all five of the bullet points
