What does PASS stand for?

Pupil Attitudes to Self and School

PASS can help support students in feeling more positive about themselves and can help build positive teacher/pupil relations in the process.

Social and emotional wellbeing is essential for effective learning, yet there will always be students who lack confidence in their learning and who don't always feel connected with school and their teachers.

What's involved in PASS?

Students respond to a series of statements about school and learning. There are 50 questions in total and it will take approximately 20 minutes to complete. There are no right or wrong answers. Students are encouraged to answer as truthfully as they can so that Pastoral Leaders can address and support any areas of need for your child.

All Year 10 students will be taking part in PASS on <u>Wednesday 23rd November</u>. These dates have already been sent out within the examinations timetable.

There is nothing that your child has to do in order to prepare for this. All we ask is that your child answers truthfully and honestly. Remember, there are no right or wrong answers.
