What's involved in PASS?

Pupils respond to a series of statements about school and learning. There are 50 questions in total and it will take approximately 20 minutes to complete. **There are no right or wrong answers.** Pupils are encouraged to answer as truthfully as they can so that pastoral leaders can address and support any areas of need for your child.

You will be in school as normal. You will come out of class for the PASS testing and then return to class for the remainder of the day and follow your normal timetable. There is nothing that you have to do in order to prepare for this. All we ask is that you answer truthfully and honestly. Remember, there are **no right or wrong answers.**

What is CAT4?

The Cognitive Abilities Test (CAT4) is a diagnostic assessment that is designed to help students and their teachers understand how they learn and what their academic potential might be. Results help teachers decide about the pace of learning that is right for a student and whether additional support or challenge is needed.

Tasks involve thinking about shapes and patterns (non-verbal reasoning), words (verbal reasoning), numbers (quantitative reasoning) and some questions are answered by mentally generating and transforming visual images (spatial ability).

How are CAT4 results used?

CAT4 provides teachers with information that can form discussions about how best a student can learn and reach his or her potential in school. Teachers are provided with an individual profile of learning preference along with a range of indicators of likely future performance.

What's involved in the CAT4 test?

CAT4 is a timed assessment and is administered under formal conditions. However, each section of the assessment includes introductory information with practice examples, and these will familiarise the children with the style and format of the questions.
